Lesson Plan	<p><b>Getting Started:</b> Log into Microsoft Sway and review these <a href="#">steps</a> with your students.</p> <p><b>Guiding Question Examples:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When thinking back over the 2020-2021 school year, what are some highlights?</li> <li>How has this school year changed you?</li> <li>What did you learn about yourself?</li> <li>How does format, conventions and technique enhance media text?</li> <li>What are the most important components when creating a digital scrapbook?</li> </ol> <p><b>Example - Co-Created Success Criteria for Students</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create and plan out a list of your top memories and/or projects from the school year</li> <li>Open a new Sway or create one from a template.</li> <li>Include titles, headings and text boxes to format and add style to your Sway</li> <li>Add pictures and video from a variety of appropriate sources (with permissions)</li> <li>Spice up your Sway with creative layouts, themes, animations, audio clips, and links</li> <li>Share your Sway with your class community through Teams</li> </ul> <p><b>Action Tasks for Teacher:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Log in student Microsoft Office 365 accounts and access Sway</li> <li>Watch and follow along with the video attached to this lesson plan. Pause and play as you go.</li> <li>Create new Sway or start from a template to house all of your students' Sways that they create.</li> <li>Embedded each Sway link sent from each student into the Sway you have created.</li> <li>Format and edit Sway to be eye-catching, meaningful and inspiring</li> <li>Share final digital scrapbook Sway with your class</li> </ol> <p><b>Consolidation:</b> Watch, reflect and enjoy the Sways created by your students!</p>
